Day 1: Thursday, February 26, 2026 Overnight Flight It's time to live the good life and embark on a getaway to the fabulous French Riviera, or *Côte d'Azur*. With its elegant coastal resorts, superb eateries, chic boutiques, and captivating museums, it's the ultimate sunny retreat for the elite. Unpack your bags just once and stay at a single hotel for your entire adventure, which begins with an overnight flight to France.

Day 2: Friday, February 27, 2026 Nice (French Riviera), France - Tour Begins Your tour commences in the stunning city of Nice, a coastal pearl of the Mediterranean known for its legendary opulence and balmy beaches. With an average of 300 sunny days per year, Nice is a seaside paradise. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner in *Vieux Nice* featuring Mediterranean-inspired French cuisine. 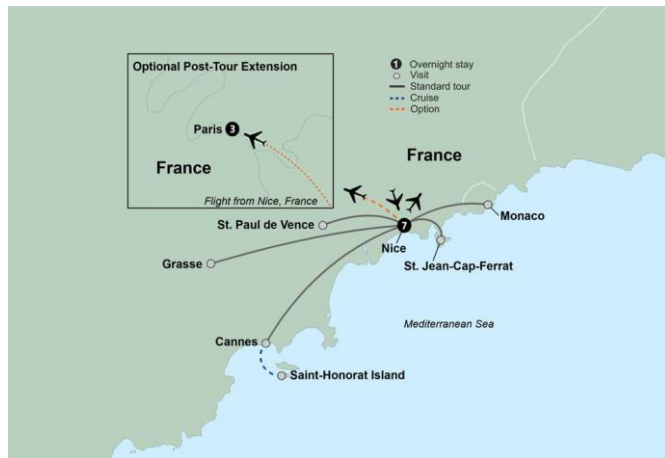

Day 4: Sunday, March 1, 2026 Nice - Monaco - Monte Carlo - Nice Travel along the spectacular *Corniche* coastal road to the Principality of Monaco. On a walking tour, view the changing of the guards and visit the Cathedral of Monaco – the permanent resting place of Prince Rainier III and Princess Grace. Then **it's your choice!** Explore the tiny country on a panoramic Little Train tour* taking you across to Monte Carlo for views of its famous casino **-OR-** visit the Oceanographic Museum, perusing its aquarium and the collection of fossils and skeletons amassed by the great researcher Jacques Cousteau. Day 5: Monday, March 2, 2026 Nice - Grasse - Nice Today, learn the secrets of perfume making during a hands-on workshop and tour of the Fragonard perfumery, where fragrant formulations have been prepared since 1782. Spend time soaking up the atmosphere of this charming *Provençal* hill town before returning to Nice for an evening at leisure. (B)

Day 6: Tuesday, March 3, 2026 Nice - Cannes - Nice Journey to the countryside to get to know a family-run winery's story. Pause to taste the locally produced wine before continuing to Cannes to perhaps rub elbows with Europe's elite. Walk in the footsteps of celebrities when you see the Film Festival Palace and the iconic red carpet featured during the Cannes Film Festival. During your free time, explore the cobbled lanes of the *Le Suquet* neighborhood or the lively Forville farmers' market. Then return to Nice in the late afternoon. In Nice this evening, savor a tasting menu highlighting the delights of the south of France. (B, D)

Day 7: Wednesday, March 4, 2026 Nice - Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat - Nice Head to Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, referred to as the crown jewel of the French Riviera, where you'll visit the impressive Villa Ephrussi de Rothschild. Uncover the lush gardens replete with jaw-dropping views of the Mediterranean Sea. Your visit to the villa is complete with lunch served in the charming tearoom overlooking the Bay of Villefranche. Back in Nice, enjoy free time to relax and take in the laid-back atmosphere along the Riviera. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion that takes you to the Italian French

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices. In particular, your visits of Monaco, the Gardens of Villa Rothschild and St. Paul de Vence village involve negotiating some steep inclines over cobblestones, gravel or multiple flights of steps. Some of the most unique sightseeing can mean accessing locations that restrict motor coaches, especially in historic areas such as the Old Town of Nice, Monaco, Saint-Honorat Island and St. Paul de Vence. For your comfort, we recommend bringing walking shoes. If you require a walker or wheelchair, or have difficulty walking, you may not be able to access some of these areas and may want to consider an alternate program with us. Our Client Care Agents can provide additional information or assistance to help you determine the perfect trip for you.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

*The Little Train tour operates from February to mid-November. In the other months, travelers selecting this choice will transfer to the Monte Carlo district by public bus.

**The Saint-Honorat Island cruise operates weather permitting, is dependent on sea conditions, and is only available from April to October. Tours from November through the end of March will visit an alternate winery.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Day 9: Nice (French Riviera) - Paris

Head to the airport for your flight to the French capital. In under two hours, you'll be in Paris, the "City of Light." Depending on your flight arrival time, you may get a chance to explore your hotel's neighborhood with your Tour Manager. Later, join your local expert to take *Le Métro* (the city's famed underground transport system) and explore the Notre Dame Cathedral neighborhood. Enjoy the rest of the evening at leisure.

Day 10: Paris

This morning, join your local expert and head back to *Le Métro* to get to the hip neighborhood of Montmartre. Blending artistic roots and quirky modernity, the 18th *arrondissement* is home to classical painters and cultural provocateurs. After trying a local café, take advantage of free time this afternoon to explore on your own. Perhaps you'll browse the shops of the *Opéra* district, where you'll have time to peruse luxury Parisian retailers, or take a stroll down the Champs-Élysées. As your day comes to a close, make the most of an evening at leisure. If you'd prefer to do something with the group, you can join an optional dinner at the Paradis Latin* for a can-can kicking, music-driven night at the cabaret. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 11: Paris

It's your last day in Paris – how will you spend it? Perhaps you'll explore *Le Marais*, a trendy district with winding streets, gorgeous old mansions, and independent boutiques, or meander through Place des Vosges, the oldest planned town square in all of Paris. You can also choose to join an optional visit to the Suresnes American Cemetery in Paris, a memorial and resting place of more than 1,500 American servicemen and women from both world wars. This evening, take in an exclusive view of Paris from the Montparnasse Tower. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 12: Paris - Extension Ends

Wish Paris *au revoir* as your tour comes to an end. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Please Note:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 4. This means you can handle longer walking tours (more than 3 hours and 3+ miles), traversing dusty or uneven terrain, standing for periods of time, varying altitudes and temperatures, and don't mind being on the go with some early starts, late-night experiences, and full days. You can handle altitudes above 9,000 feet/2,743 meters. Unfortunately, this level is not appropriate for individuals who use wheelchairs, walkers and other mobility assistance devices.

This is a **Fully Guided** extension, perfect for travelers who want the complete experience of a new destination and local expertise. Travelers will have a dedicated guide throughout this entire extension. Experience all the inclusions of a Collette tour, such as overnight accommodations, airport transportation (to and from), daily breakfast, some lunches and dinners, sightseeing, and local experiences, all led by a Tour Manager or local expert.

Extensions not purchased at time of deposit are subject to availability and applicable charges at time of request.

We reserve the right to cancel this extension if a minimum of 7 passengers is not met to operate.

Using the Paris underground system requires the ability to negotiate 2 to 3 flights of stairs and agility to step on and off moving escalators. Seating is not guaranteed in the Métro as it's available on a first come, first served basis. In case seats are not available, the ability to stand in a moving vehicle is required (handrails are available). Most underground stations are not wheelchair accessible.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

*Paradis Latin may be considered unsuitable for children - consult your Tour Manager.

If you intend to visit well-known tourist sites of Paris, like The Louvre Museum or the Eiffel Tower, we recommend that you purchase tickets a few months ahead.
