Day 1: Thursday, December 2, 2027 Overnight Flight An overnight flight takes you to Italy. Journey through southern Italy and experience its rich scenery, art, culture, food, and wine. During the holiday season, Italy's festive spirit greets you with buzzing shopping streets, twinkling decorations, and delicious traditions. From Rome to Sorrento, feel the joy in the air among locals and discover Italy's inviting winter ambiance.

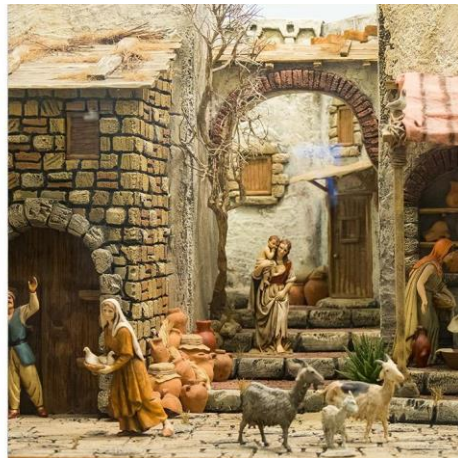
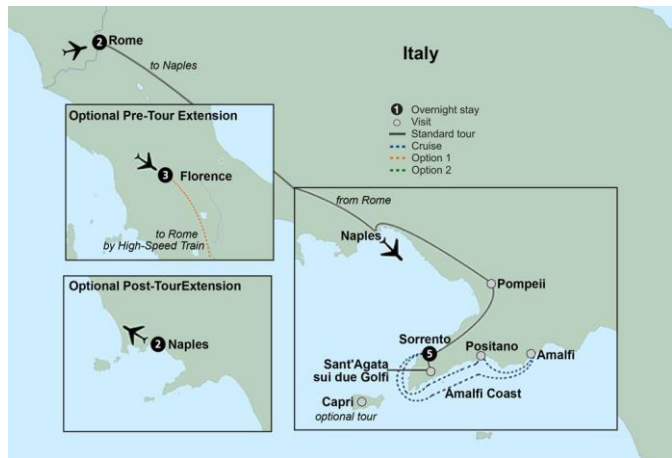
Day 2: Friday, December 3, 2027 Rome, Italy Arrive in the "Eternal City" of Rome! This city, steeped in history and tradition, comes alive with holiday shoppers, decorated streets, and a cheerful atmosphere. As arrival times will vary, there is no scheduled sightseeing today. Spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink celebrating the start of your Italian journey.

Day 3: Saturday, December 4, 2027 Rome Begin your exploration of the Eternal City with an expert-guided tour of Rome's Renaissance and Baroque highlights. Climb to the top of the Spanish Steps for views of the city's skyline and down its famous 135 stairs. Stroll over cobblestone streets and weathered passageways to discover famous sights such as the Trevi Fountain and the Pantheon's imposing facade. Finish a full morning of exploration in the oval-shaped Piazza Navona. Then, make the most of a free afternoon in Italy's capital city. Maybe you'll set off for Saint Peter's Square to take in the iconic scene. Or do as the Romans do and take care of some holiday shopping along Via del Corso before gathering for dinner at a local restaurant. (B, D)

Day 4: Sunday, December 5, 2027 Rome - Pompeii - Sorrento Journey to the Sorrentine Peninsula, an iconic coastline of rocky beaches and towering cliffs. En route, pause at a local winery to savor the area's famous *Lacryma Christi*. Enjoy a typical lunch before experiencing the eerily preserved ruins of Pompeii your way, because **it's your choice!** Pick between a leisurely-paced tour of the highlights **-OR-** a faster-paced visit combining the highlights with Pompeii's further-out gems. In the late afternoon, settle into your hotel in Sorrento.* Take some time to explore the property, perched in a scenic location above town and sea. As dusk falls, the Bay of Naples lights up with twinkling lights from the towns along its coast. As you settle into your home for the next five nights, you might even catch a glimpse of Mount Vesuvius in the distance, the volcano that famously erupted and buried Pompeii. (B, L)

Day 5: Monday, December 6, 2027 Sorrento This morning, set out for an orientation walk of Sorrento. Located along the southern cliffs of the Bay of Naples, this picturesque resort town is packed with holiday charm and smiling locals. Then, join a hands-on cooking class following family recipes. Dig into the lunch you helped make, a true taste of traditional holiday dishes of the region. The afternoon is yours. Join the locals for a *passaggiata* (stroll), wandering through Sorrento's narrow streets and colorful boutiques, perhaps sampling some gelato made with local lemons. (B, L)

Day 6: Tuesday, December 7, 2027 Sorrento - Naples - Sorrento Today, discover the sights of Naples during a walking tour through the city's historic center. Get an up-close look at why Neapolitan nativity scenes are renowned for their intricate detail and craftsmanship. This Christmas tradition dates back centuries and is deeply ingrained in the city's cultural heritage. Enjoy time on your own for lunch and exploring more as you wish, before returning to Sorrento for the evening. (B)

Coast - Sorrento Drive** along the stunning Amalfi Coast to its namesake town, Amalfi. A former trading hub, Amalfi is now a quiet coastal town of historic landmarks and a black-and-white marble cathedral. Explore on your own before driving up to nearby Ravello. Stroll the gardens of Villa Rufolo and admire views of *la costiera* (the coastline, as locals affectionally call it), ahead of returning to Sorrento for an evening at leisure. (B)

Day 8: Thursday, December 9, 2027 Sorrento This morning, explore another side of Sorrento during a locally guided walking tour, showing off its allure - legend has it that Sirens once lured sailors to Sorrento's shores. See why Enrico Caruso, the famous tenor who sung *Torna a Surriento*, was so captivated by Sorrento's beauty, he often made it his holiday retreat. Along the way, sample local flavors and venture down to Marina Grande, Sorrento's old fishing village. Ending by the seaside, linger longer if you wish, with time to find lunch on your own, or stroll along the tiny fishermen wharf, before heading back to the main part of town. Enjoy the relaxing

beauty of Sorrento during an afternoon at leisure, then join your fellow travelers for a holiday-inspired farewell dinner. Gather together and bid *salute* to the end of your Italian getaway. (B, D)

Day 9: Friday, December 10, 2027 Sorrento - Tour Ends Your tour comes to a close today. (B)

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

In historic areas such as Rome, Sorrento, Ravello, and Amalfi, extensive walking over cobblestones, uneven and often narrow sidewalks, and occasionally unpaved terrain with loose gravel will be required.

The archeological site of Pompeii is entirely pedestrianized, and the only access is via a steep ancient Roman street which is uphill and paved with huge, slippery cobblestones. Therefore, the site is not "accessible" by disabled standards. Throughout the archeological site, you will need to negotiate large cobblestones and steep sidewalks. There are NO vehicles inside the site, which is extremely vast.

In Rome, you must be prepared to walk approximately 2.2 miles (3.6 kilometers) and to climb down the 135 stairs of the Spanish Steps in order to complete the included guided walking tour, with no opportunity to sit.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, walkers, or Zimmer-frames.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Days of features are interchangeable.

Shops and businesses in smaller towns and villages are generally closed on Sundays, while in larger cities they typically remain open but do close on national/religious holidays.

*During your stay in Sorrento, standard accommodations at the Hilton Sorrento Palace are in rooms facing the road and hillside. Upgrades to superior rooms with a balcony and partial views of the coastline and garden are available at an additional cost. Some departures will be accommodated in other Sorrento hotels which may not offer coastal view upgrades. Please inquire at the time of booking.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Italy imposes strict limits on motorcoach circulation and mandatory drop-off and pick-up points, especially in historic areas such as Rome, Sorrento, Ravello, and Amalfi. The same applies for the optional sightseeing tour outlined in the itinerary.

**Due to the narrow and winding nature of Amalfi Drive, local authorities impose strict limits on the circulation of full-size motorcoaches. Therefore,

your full-day visit to the Amalfi Coast will be operated using 16/19-seater minibuses. These vehicles are narrower and shorter than regular coaches, resulting in significantly reduced legroom. Travelers prone to motion sickness should take appropriate precautions.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

Our air travelers will depart from Naples airport.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Please be advised, many airlines do not provide advance seat assignments until check-in at the airport. Advance seating will be subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

Prepaid tipping is not available on our tours therefore payment of customary end-of-trip gratuities for your Tour Manager, driver, hotel housekeepers, and cruise ship waitstaff should be handled individually when applicable during the course of your tour.

Day 1: Overnight Flight

You are on your way to Florence, the "Cradle of the Renaissance."

Day 2: Florence, Italy

Get settled into Florence for your 3-night stay. Your local host will meet you at the hotel for an orientation briefing before leading you on a neighborhood walk, providing you with dining suggestions for your evening at leisure.

Day 3: Florence

Start your morning with a locally guided walking tour of Florence's cultural treasures, passing by the Duomo, the Baptistery, the Palazzo Vecchio, and the Piazza della Signoria. The afternoon is yours to browse the shops of via Tornabuoni or perhaps visit one of the city's great museums* such as the Uffizi or the Accademia, which houses Michelangelo's statue of *David*. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Florence

Explore Florence's bohemian *Oltrarno* district during a guided walking tour of the city's Left Bank. *Oltrarno* literally means "on the other side of the Arno," the river which runs through Florence. Grasp the spirit of this "Florence of the Florentines." Here, the last craftsmen, the market stalls, the gardens and churches, the typical restaurants and cafés still move at the gentle rhythm of everyday life, away from the hustle and bustle of Florence's more famous monuments. The *Oltrarno* was so dear to the Medici family, Florence's great rulers, that they made it their home by establishing themselves in the Pitti Palace. The remainder of the day is yours to explore more of Florence. Perhaps you'll venture up to Piazzale Michelangelo, a panoramic terrace offering charming views over the city's towers and domes. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Florence - Rome

Your Florentine sojourn comes to a close today. Say *arrivederci* as you transfer to Rome by high-speed train** to begin your tour. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Important Tour Extension Information:

The overall activity level of this extension is a level 3. This means walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal for you. You can navigate hills and uneven ground, climb into various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.), and could possibly anticipate changes in elevation. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable as is climbing 3 flights of stairs. You can handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. You can expect some longer days balanced with free time. This level is not a fit for travelers that require mobility assistance devices.

During this extension, you can expect to have a **hosted** experience or two, with a local representative revealing more of what this destination has to offer. Enjoy a mix of independent exploration and guided sightseeing and experiences.

The space on this extension is limited and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Applicable charges may apply at time of request.

We reserve the right to cancel this extension if a minimum of 4 travelers is not met to operate.

**Porterage is not available at the Florence and Rome train stations. You must be able to handle your luggage on and off the trains, including 2 steps to lift the luggage onto your assigned carriage as there is no checked luggage service available on Italian trains.

The included sightseeing will take place entirely on foot as the monuments district of Florence is mostly pedestrianized.

The included activities are not suitable for travelers using motorized scooters, wheelchairs, walkers, or Zimmer-frames.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at the time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

Florence is paved with cobblestones, and the sidewalks are very narrow. Please be mindful of your step and watch out for small potholes and loose stones.

You should expect large crowds in Florence and Rome.

*During your free time in Florence, you may wish to visit the Academy Gallery (Accademia) or the Uffizi Museums. Both are closed on Mondays, and both require reservations, as tickets are often sold out on the day or close to the day of visit. If you are interested, we recommend you purchase tickets online, prior to departure, through the museum's official website. We also recommend you schedule any possible museum visit in the afternoons of your touring days in Florence. You can expect your two included walking tours to conclude at the latest by 1:00 p.m.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Air inclusive rate is valid for travelers who have purchased our air package for the full tour, depending on the air schedule selected. Rate may vary for those who have purchased their own air.
