Day 1: Monday, September 20, 2027 Overnight Flight

Embark on a captivating journey through the Imperial Cities of Central Europe: Prague, Vienna, and Budapest. Along the way, immerse yourself in centuries-old history, vibrant cultural traditions, and local culinary experiences that bring this remarkable region to life.

Day 2: Tuesday, September 21, 2027 Prague, Czech Republic

Arrive in Prague, the "City of 100 Spires," where Gothic towers and cobblestone lanes evoke centuries past. With no scheduled activities, spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant, marking the beginning of your Central European adventure. (D)

Day 3: Wednesday, September 22, 2027 Prague

Step into Prague's fairytale charm as you explore the best of Prague's Old Town and its iconic landmarks. Marvel at the statue-lined Charles Bridge spanning the Vltava River and admire the city's striking architecture. After free time for lunch, enjoy an afternoon and evening at leisure, discovering the city on your own. Perhaps you'll join an optional excursion to the Old Jewish Quarter, home to the historic Jewish Museum and one of Europe's oldest Jewish cemeteries, founded in 1478. (B)

Day 4: Thursday, September 23, 2027 Prague

Begin with a panoramic tour before exploring the "Castle District," including Prague Castle, the awe-inspiring St. Vitus Cathedral, and the charming Golden Lane. The afternoon is yours to explore independently. You may consider shopping for Bohemian crystal or visit one of the city's museums, such as the Lapidarium or Klementinum Baroque* library. Tonight, enjoy a traditional Czech dinner paired with a vibrant folklore performance, celebrating recipes and traditions passed down through generations. (B, D)

Day 5: Friday, September 24, 2027 Prague - Český Krumlov - Vienna, Austria

Travel through the scenic Bohemian countryside to the medieval gem of Český Krumlov. Wander its winding streets framed by colorful Baroque façades before continuing to the grand city of Vienna. This evening, join your Tour Manager for an evening stroll before dining independently. (B)

Day 6: Saturday, September 25, 2027 Vienna

Join a local guide for a visit to the magnificent Schönbrunn Palace, the lavish summer retreat of the Habsburg dynasty for over two centuries. Continue into Vienna's historic center, where grand boulevards, ornate architecture, and manicured parks reflect the city's imperial legacy. Spend the afternoon at leisure, perhaps embracing Vienna's celebrated café culture. This evening, hear Vienna's past come alive and experience a classical performance featuring the timeless works of Mozart and Strauss. (B, D)

Day 7: Sunday, September 26, 2027 Vienna

Choose how you spend your day because **it's your choice!** Venture down the Danube** to the medieval town of Durnstein and cruise to the 11th-century Melk Abbey **-OR-** join a local guide in exploring the Belvedere Museum, home to Gustav Klimt's iconic painting *The Kiss* **-OR-** enjoy a leisurely morning before participating in a Viennese Waltz lesson in the afternoon. The rest of the day is yours. (B)

Day 8: Monday, September 27, 2027 Vienna - Bratislava, Slovakia - Budapest, Hungary Travel to Bratislava, once an imperial capital of the Habsburg Empire. Join a local guide to uncover the city's rich history and layered past. Continue to Hungary for an immersive cultural experience at a rustic Hungarian event house dedicated to preserving centuries-old local traditions. Learn to prepare traditional strudel before enjoying a hearty lunch featuring classic Hungarian goulash. Arrive in Budapest, the "Queen of the Danube" and your home for the next three nights. Enjoy the evening on your own. (B, L)

Day 9: Tuesday, September 28, 2027 Budapest Uncover the magic of Budapest with a local expert as your guide. Wander through iconic landmarks like the stunning Matthias Church perched on Buda Castle Hill, marvel at the fairytale-like Fisherman's Bastion, pass by the charming streets of historic Old Buda, and take in the impressive exterior of the Parliament House. The afternoon is yours to explore independently. Perhaps unwind in one of the city's famous

thermal pools*** for an afternoon of relaxation, or maybe you'll join an optional excursion to discover Budapest by night. (B)

Day 10: Wednesday, September 29, 2027 Budapest - Szentendre - Budapest Set out on a scenic drive along the Danube Bend to the charming riverside town of Szentendre, celebrated for its colorful streets and artistic spirit. Stroll through the picturesque Old Town on a guided walking tour with your Tour Manager and soak in the stunning views along the Danube Promenade. Savor a relaxing lunch at a local restaurant featuring regional flavors and warm hospitality. Later, return to Budapest and enjoy some time at leisure. This evening, gather with your fellow travelers to celebrate your journey with a farewell cocktail, the perfect way to end your memorable trip. (B, L)

Day 11: Thursday, September 30, 2027 Budapest - Tour Ends Say goodbye to these regal cities as your tour comes to a close today. (B)

Important Tour Information:

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

In Budapest, not all major sites can be approached by coach. The 3-hour city tour includes significant amounts of walking and using public transportation at times.

The Prague Castle visit lasts approximately 3 hours and includes standing for longer periods of time.

During the Prague city tour you can expect up to 2.5 hours of walking, with stops, and be prepared for walking on uneven surfaces.

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

This tour spans Central and Eastern Europe, where weather can vary significantly from spring to late autumn. From April to May, temperatures are generally mild, with occasional rain showers and cool mornings and evenings. Summer months (June to August) are warm, and occasional heatwaves can occur. From September to November, temperatures gradually cool, especially in the evenings, and rain becomes more frequent.

On this tour, you will be walking on uneven surfaces, cobblestone streets, and historic sites, including castles, old towns, and city streets that may have steps or inclines. Some destinations, such as Prague Castle, Český Krumlov, Vienna, and Budapest, require extended walking and occasional stair climbing.

The transfer from Prague to Vienna, Austria, with a stop in Český Krumlov for independent exploration, can take up to 10 hours.

The transfer from Vienna to Budapest, with stops in Bratislava and for an included activity in the Hungarian countryside, can take up to 10 hours.

******The Danube River cruise to Melk Abbey is available mid-April to mid-October. Outside of these times, a cruise through Vienna will be substituted.

***If** you plan to visit the Klementium Library in Prague, it is recommended to book the tickets in advance through the Klementium's official website, as entry is available only on guided tours and spaces are limited.

*****If** you wish to visit one of Budapest's famous thermal baths during free time, it is recommended to reserve tickets in advance through the bath's official website, as availability may be limited.

Hotel check-in on your day of arrival is 3:00 p.m. Rooms may not be available prior to that time.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that travelers take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

While visas are not required for U.S., Australian, New Zealand, UK, or Canadian citizens for a stay of up to 90 days, we recommend you inquire with your consulate for further information.

Visitors are required to show proof of travel medical insurance to travel to the Czech Republic. The health insurance must cover medical services abroad with specific coverages. Please visit <https://travel.state.gov> (the U.S. State Department) for the latest details with regards to entry requirements. If you have **purchased our Travel Protection Plan**, your coverage meets this requirement.
